OVERVIEW

More than 150 staff members including teachers, paraprofessionals, counselors, nurses, therapists, EL staff, psychologists, interpreters, diagnosticians, administrative assistants, school resource officers, Native American liaison and advocate, social worker and others work under the umbrella of Student Services.



HIGHLIGHTS

PCSD's Student Services:

- Offers a continuum of services that are provided in the Least Restrictive Environment for each student who is in need of specialized instruction and/or related services.
- Offers comprehensive school counseling curriculum at all schools and access to a mental health provider.
- Ensures access to the school resource officers in all buildings.
- Offers grades 6-12 academic career planning.

Student Services provides professional development to staff, including topics such as:

- mental health;
- poverty;
- culturally responsive education;
- suicide prevention resources;
- child abuse prevention training;
- life-threatening allergies education; and
- medication administration.
